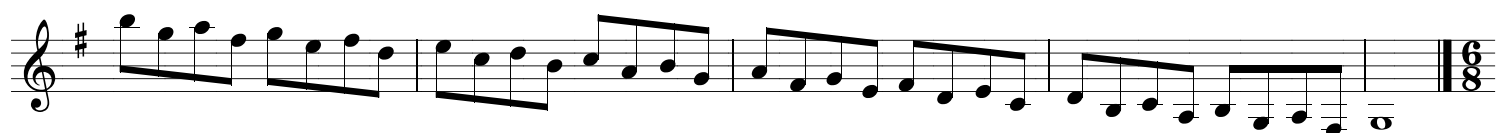
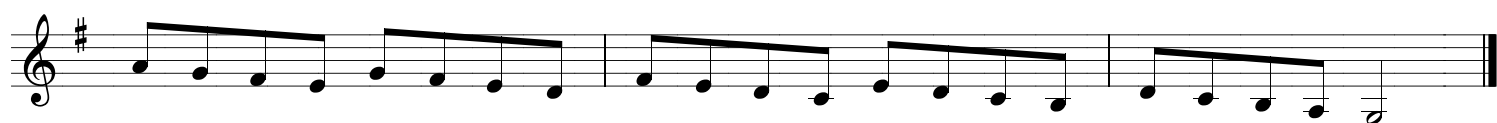


Scale Sequences
